## FFD-Hope

In Vietnam, we continued the implementation of the FFD-Hope program to support the carbon sequestration of smallholders through acacia forests. With the help of a digital application developed by Simosol, producers can measure the growth of trees and the application calculates the carbon sequestration. Cooperatives manage funds to promote climate activities for common good and individual producers receive incentives to let their trees grow longer. FFD Hope operates according to the recommendations of the international climate panel and the application reliably measures carbon.

## Communication and Global Education

FFD's communication and global education project "Reconstructing our Food System" 2021-2022 examined Finland as part of the global food system and evaluated the ways and models by which Finnish actors work together to promote a more sustainable, fairer and more inclusive food system.
