

FORESTRY- ZENBABA COOPERATIVE Zenbaba increased its turnover by 77% from 2018, and improved the productivity of its 8 000 members. 33 new nurseries were established producing 1 730 429 tree seedlings. Zenbaba has re-launched marketing and processing of honey and continued charcoal production. Trainings in Sustainable Forest Management and to enhance forestry value chain motivated the increase of 280 ha of sustainably managed forests. 312 members were trained in agroforestry, beekeeping, marketing and finances.

TANZANIA

HORTICULTURE—TAHA TAHA is becoming a key actor in increasing Zanzibar's food self-sufficiency through leadership in decision-making, advocacy and

increased quality and yields of horticultural products. The key of success is based on TAHA's staff trainings increased its operational capacity and representativity. In 2019, five women were promoted to managerial positions. Another contributing factor is the application of Good Agricultural Practices (853 ha) and investments in drip irrigation. Greenhouses has brought more than 50% increase in sales, 40% in yields and 13% in income. Hotels are realizing the good quality of local product and sales agreements are increasing.

AGRICULTURE —AKA COMERCIAL

In 2019, AKA has supported 1 760 farmers to increase their resilience, income, and food security by focusing on crop diversification and business-oriented activities. AKA trained 162 farmers in conservation agriculture (crop rotation, cover crops and reduced tillage). Furthermore, agroforestry systems were introduced, and 15 000 cashew trees were distributed to farmers for intercropping with annual crops. A training nursery was established and 4 000 fruit trees and 2 000 nitrogen fixing trees were planted to be distributed to farmers. In addition, 52 livestock promoters were trained to facilitate the raising of small animals. In parallel, AKA is improving its operational and administrative processes to provide better services to farmers. In 2020 AKA will work to develop a corn value chain producing corn flour.
