ETHIOPIA Zenbaba Union has worked to increase income and skills of their members. In 2018, 8581 farmers have increased their income by increasing charcoal,

timber poles, seedlings and honey sales. Furthermore, a forest management plan has been developed for 500 ha increasing the area under Sustainable Forest Management. Members' skills have increased in Sustainable Forest Management practices and in improving forest value chains.

TANZANIA

TAHA in Zanzibar has strengthened its organizational capacity by training staff on leadership and management skills. Furthermore,

trainings of members on Good Agricultural Practices, post - harvest practices and management achieved great results: 2380 farmers increased productivity, improved their sales, resulting in increased income. In addition, TAHA supported value chain development through better financial management, new market linkages and implementation GAP standards for fruits and vegetables to facilitate trade and export.
